Are Electronic Dog Collars Safe?

Should you have a mature dog with a few behavioral problems, no doubt you've begun to think of possible methods to teaching him or her. There are lots of methodologies and ideas to help your pet conquer any negative actions which might be making you crazy. One such approach that has become very popular and appropriate these days is the usage of an electric training collar like the [Dogtra 202 NCP Gold](#), as an example.

Those who are against electronic dog collars, or shock collars, most likely don't have a clear picture of what the collar really does. They might have even noticed something on television or read concerning an instance with intense measure, however the actual training collar is actually really secure and efficient for the canine.

The digital dog training collar functions by getting your dog's attention via a small, but not dangerous shock. This shock comes at the neck where the canine is wearing the dog collar or receiver and the transmitter can be used at a relatively good distance from your dog and still be quite successful. These types of collars for dogs are meant to be used by the dog for instruction purposes only and not a part of their everyday attire.

When applied successfully, instruction dog collars such as the [Dogtra 202 NCP](#) can get rid of several bad behavior in dogs. These actions might include things like leaping up on guests, chasing after cars or bicycles, too much chewing, digging in the backyard, insane amounts of barking and any other number of bad behaviors which you would like to see altered within your residence.

The most important bit of the puzzle when it comes to using the electronic dog collar successfully has to do with the understanding of the dog owner or the particular person accountable for transferring the shocks. Be sure to make an effort to go through the training dog collar directions and operations manual allowing you to have a clear knowledge of how you can begin your instruction sessions. You will find correct and wrong methods to start and you do not want to begin on the completely wrong foot because it can confuse your puppy and impede the training process.

The [Dogtra 202](#) is a superb illustration of a fantastic entry level training collar to use on your dog if you are just getting started. It is a lower to medium power training collar and is good for many of the situations and behavior modifications mentioned above. This one has an operational range of 1/2 mile and this is common amongst the majority of the collars for dogs of this level.

This Dogtra training collar, just like lots of the others, has three settings to pick from. You are able to set it to transfer a quick 1 time shock which is known as the nick setting. There is also a continual function which allows a minimal level shock to be transmitted for twelve seconds prior to immediately turning off as a basic safety precaution. Last but not least, you can also select the pager setting that is totally non-electrical and primarily employed as soon as your puppy is properly trained and simply requires a gentle indication in the form of a vibration to the collar.

No matter whether or not you allow the electronic digital canine training collar a try, do spend some time doing your study to remove certain preconceived notions of just what this process is about. Your own pet's conduct can be changed in no time and this is often an ideal answer for the pet dog.
