Dog Obedience Problems Should Be Avoided Right From The Start

Dog obedience problems can arise because of quite a few issues. One of the most critical things to bear in mind is that obedience training starts before you even bring the dog home. In the event you reside with others, it can be essential to get everybody aboard to be certain that training is positive and consistent.

Make a decision beforehand such things as where the dog will be let outdoors to go to the bathroom and exercise. Have a designated place that they will eat their meals. Is one individual going to be responsible for walking the pet or will it be an activity that will have people taking turns? Having a number of the fundamentals in place beforehand is likely to make it a lot easier when you actually bring your dog home.

Some of the most typical dog obedience problems involve jumping on people, barking excessively, chewing on things it shouldn't and playing too rough. Regular training using positive reinforcement has to be started at the very beginning and continued regularly. You will need to be certain that the dog knows basic obedience commands like sit, stay and down. Set very clear boundaries about what's appropriate and what's not. When the dog jumps up on you once and you do not correct it but the next time you discipline him for it, you will be sending him really mixed signals.

This poor communication will not just serve to confuse your dog, it will make it more difficult to discipline him because he will not clearly comprehend what you are expecting. Ensure that your commands are very clear, consistent and authoritative. If barking turns into an issue, first look to see if there are outside issues creating this problem. Is your dog hungry, cold, stuck or tangled up? Many things could cause him to bark so first check to make certain that it is not an issue like this. When barking is extreme without any root cause, be consistent with letting them understand it isn't acceptable. Spending additional time with your pet and making sure he's receiving adequate physical exercise can in some cases make a significant difference.

Dog obedience problems don't need to create strain and chaos in a household. Make properly training your pet a major priority and be consistent. Before you realize it, you will have a dog that is well-behaved and a joy to have around.
