# How To Choose The Best Dog Gate

Hardware pet gates are secured by nails that insert into a stud in the wall. This style of gate can be used for both pets and kids. This allows you to step through with relative ease. While these gates will plant holes in your wall, its nothing someone couldn't easily fix. With pressure mounted gates, there may be some spots on the wall to touch up, hardware mounted gates require you to refill holes in the wall as well.

A freestanding gate is the next kind of dog gate. They do not require any installation. They require nothing in the realm of wall area, and as the name implies, stand on their own. As such, they can be located in any doorway without the need to place hardware or danger to your walls. They have extended feet that are rubber lined to keep them from sliding or damaging your flooring. The trap is that these barriers tend to be on the petite side, and some animals just can't resist the enticement to leap over them.

No one can say that a particular gate is just right. Sometimes what is just right for you, will not work for someone else. When purchasing a gate, you need to think about your dogs temperament.
