When training your new dog, you call them by name as much as possible. Use it as often as possible when you have your puppy during the first weeks, the puppy will make the connection. Chose a name that can easily be distinguished from other words, and that has only one or two syllables.

A crate can come in handy when housebreaking a dog. In order to maximize the effectiveness of your crate training, you must make sure to allow your dog out consistently. With a little patience, crate training can make a dog very unlikely to make a mess in the house.

Provide your dog with the tools and environment to facilitate success, particularly when breaking him of the habit of inappropriate chewing. It is also important that a dog who chews is protected from danger. Many household items can be dangerous choking hazards, and some are even poisonous when chewed.

Break complex tricks into smaller behaviors when training your dog. A good example is training the dog to pick up the morning paper for you. First, your dog must be able to pick up an object and hold it in his mouth. Next, he must learn the name of the object. You need to teach him then how to pick the object up. Finally, he should learn how to bring it over to you. If you keep it simple, your dog will realize the relationship in this type of behavior.

Pay attention to the length of your dog training sessions. Spending too much time just on one aspect of training will bore your dog and waste your efforts. Keep first training lessons to 10 minutes or less.

It is vital to train your dog when it's still a puppy. The younger the dog, the better he will do when it comes to training. If your dog is young, try to train him now so that the training sticks with him when he grows up and you won't have any problems with him.

Ensure that your dog gets plenty of exercise and stimulation. Just like humans, dogs can become bored easily. When dogs are bored they are difficult to train. When your dog gets regular exercise, he will be much happier and will pay attention more easily. A long walk or a brisk run are great ways to get rid of some of your dog's excess energy.

The younger a dog is, the easier it is to train. Young dogs have more resilient brains and are easier to train. When you train your dog as a puppy, he will be a well-behaved dog throughout his life.

Start prepping your puppy for training by rewarding his good choices. It is easier to instill good habits than it is to deal with bad ones. If your goal is to keep the dog from begging for table scraps, it is advisable to never give him any table scraps to begin with.

Training your dog can be challenging, but never give up. You will need to give your dog continuous reinforcement, or he or she will go back to how they were before being trained. Realize that training your dog is a daily task, no different than feeding and sheltering it.

You should never tether two dogs in close proximity to one another. It is possible for the chains to become intertwined, and the animals can be hurt as they try to get free. Particularly in the case of a large dog and a small dog, the animals may get so tangled that the smaller dog has his airway cut off and dies.

Your dog needs to understand how to go to a vet exam. Give your pet lots of attention and positive reinforcement

during this time. Get him ready to be tolerant by having his paws and teeth checked at. You could ask the assistance of your friends, too.
