These devices can work, but you have to make sure that they are used in the right way. For example, if your dog gets a shock for boredom barking you won't fix the true cause of that barking. Any dog that is bored needs to spend more time on walks, more time playing, and more time from you. It should not be shocked just for being bored.

A great way to get your dog to stop barking at your command is to simply make a noise that gets it's attention. Some people like to do this by putting something in a cane or bottle and then shake it. It might be just as effective to blow a whistle or squirt water towards it.

Barking At Your Neighbors

Allot of dogs bark at the neighbors. If your dog likes to bark at your neighbor then I recommend that you try to introduce your dog to your neighbor. As your dog gets to know your neighbor he or she is less likely to bark at them. Be sure that your neighbors are not teasing your dog when you are not there.
